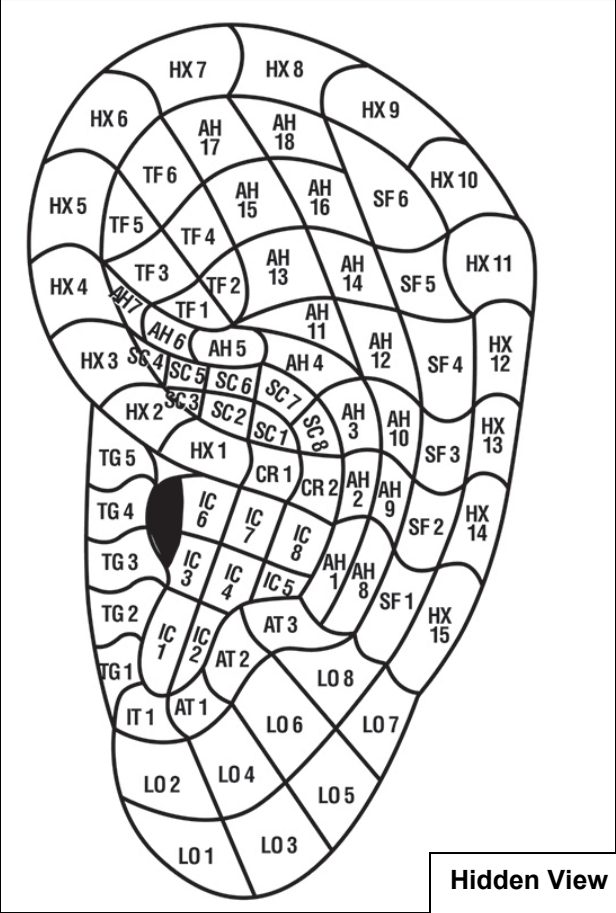

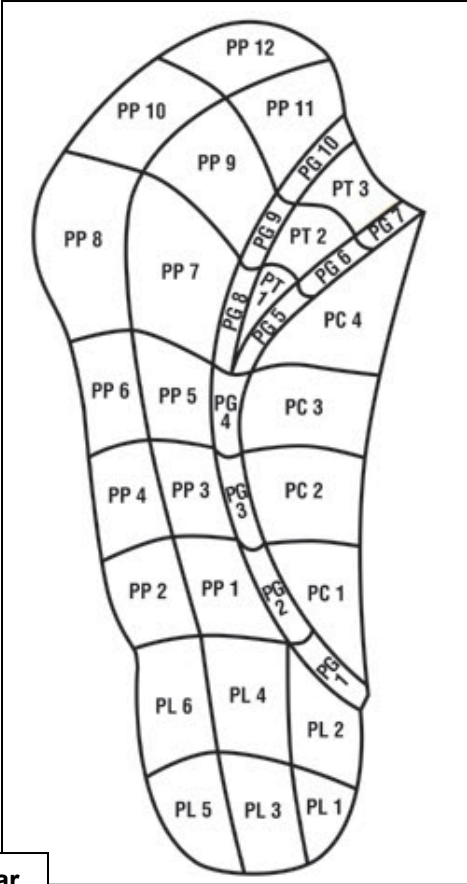

- HX = Helix
  - AH = Antihelix
  - IH = Internal Helix
  - SF = Scaphoid Fossa
  - TF = Triangular Fossa
  - TG = Tragus
  - AT = Antitragus
  - IT = Intertragic Notch
  - ST = Subtragus
  - LO = Lobe
  - SC = Superior Concha
  - IC = Inferior Concha
  - CR = Concha Ridge
  - CW = Concha Wall
  - PC = Posterior Concha
  - PP = Posterior Periphery
  - PG = Posterior Groove
  - PT = Posterior Triangle
  - PL = Posterior Lobe
